RailCats Win 5-4...David Cooper hit a go-ahead RBI single in the eighth inning in the RailCats 5-4 win over St. Paul on Thursday night. The 'Cats had taken the lead in the seventh on an RBI single from Adam Klein and two-run single by Ryan Babineau, but Willie Cabrera tied in with a two-run shot in the eighth. Stephen Hiscock threw his 11th quality outing in 18 starts, giving up three runs, two earned in 7 1/3 innings. Marco Gonzalez picked up his second save in as many nights and ninth of the season.

Playoff Picture...Winnipeg lost to Sioux City 10-1 last night but still have a three-game lead over St. Paul in the wild card, with a magic number of two to clinch. Laredo lost 2-1 at Fargo and Grand Prairie beat Sioux Falls 12-1 to pull to within 1.5 games in the South Division. Laredo's magic number is three. The AirHogs started 37-14 and are 13-33 since July 12.

Pursuit of a Winning Season...Greg Tagert has had a record over .500 in each of his first 16 seasons as a manager, and the RailCats sit at .500 with eight games left. The closest he has come to .500 was two games over in 1999 in Evansville (43-41) and 1995 in Ohio Valley (36-34). His worst record with the RailCats was 52-48 in 2010.

Milestone Watch...David Cooper has 30 stolen bases, the second-most in a RailCats single-season and is two steals away from tying Billy Brown ('03) for the single-season record of 32...Mike Massaro is two hits away from 500 as a RailCat. He currently ranks second all-time in hits behind Jay Pecci (548).

Claggett vs. 'Cats...Anthony Claggett took a no-decision at Gary on August 5 in game one of a doubleheader, giving up four runs on eight hits in five innings. He walked three and struck out five in the 'Cats 7-5 win.

Gulbransen was placed on the disabled list on August 18 with bicep tendinitis and was activated on August 26...He was signed by the RailCats on July 10 and made his first career start that night. He has a WHIP of 1.243 this season...Gulbransen was signed by the White Sox as an undrafted free agent on June 18, 2011 and spent last season pitching for Great Falls in the rookie Pioneer League. Prior to that Gulbransen pitched four collegiate seasons (2008-11) at nearby Valparaiso...His younger brother, Dan, was a 16th Round pick of the Astros in this June's draft and is hitting .219 with three homers and 32 RBI for short-season Tri-City.

2011 (Great Falls, Pioneer League): 0-1, 7.56 ERA in 17 relief appearances for the White Sox rookie affiliate. In 16 2/3 innings, gave up 14 runs, all earned, struck out 19 and walked 11. Opponents hit .343 against him.

College Career (Valparaiso): Holds the all-time school record with 327.1 innings pitched. Ranks fourth all-time with 18 victories and third all-time with 264 strikeouts. Was 18-28 with a 4.78 ERA in 59 career games.

2011: 6-8, 4.03 ERA in 16 games, 15 starts as a senior in 2011. In 91 2/3 innings he struck out 80 and walked 30. Ranked fourth in the Horizon League in wins and strikeouts. The last appearance of his college career was on May 28 at Wright State, giving up four runs in eight innings in a losing effort.

2010: 4-6 with a 4.67 ERA in 15 games, 13 starts. Ranked fourth in the Horizon League in ERA and fifth in strikeouts with 75.
